



Service is offered almost everywhere, for everyone, every day. We know public transit is promoting equality of opportunity, job creation, stronger economies and the vibrancy of neighborhoods in communities across the state of Missouri.

This year the Missouri Public Transit
Association (MPTA) is celebrating 40 years
of providing a unified voice for public and
specialized transportation providers in
Missouri and to work toward elevating the
status of public transit as a priority. Four
decades later, we continue to work to ensure
transit has a voice in Missouri. The MPTA
mission values personal mobility as a basic
quality of life by promoting access to public
transit services.

This year, MPTA took its work one step further to determine transit's economic impact on Missouri. The 2019 Economic Impact of Public Transit Services in the State of Missouri study - commissioned by the MPTA, Citizens for Modern Transit, and AARP in St. Louis – has provided the state with localized numbers tied to rider demographics, economic impacts, transit agency spending and funding sources. Findings showcased that transit is delivering in Missouri and positively impacting the state's bottom line. The direct and indirect economic output supported by public transit's annual operations this year exceeds \$3.67 billion in Missouri. Transit is delivering on its promise to Missouri.






