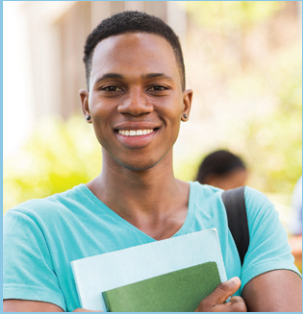

MPTA transit provider members provide more than 62 million rides almost everywhere for everybody every day in Missouri, and they employ thousands in our communities. The MPTA mission values personal mobility as a basic quality of life by promoting access to public transit services.

The facts show investment in transit increases access to jobs, education and healthcare; creates development opportunities and jobs; and provides reinvestment in the disadvantaged areas of our state. According to the American Public Transit Association, for every dollar invested in transit projects there is a \$4 return for the state.

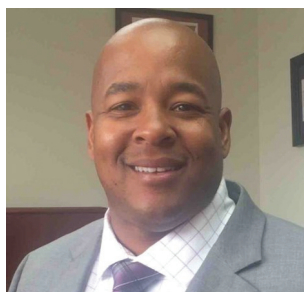

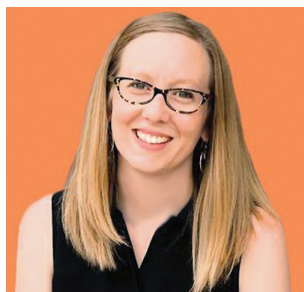
