

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




#### • FAST ACT — FY '21

- Total Transit Apportionment = \$12,829,068,462
- Rural Transit (5311) = \$728,734,295
- Tribal Transit (5311c1) = \$35,766,775
- Urban Transit (5307) = \$5,375,259,282
- Specialized (5310) = \$292,921,581
- Bus and Bus Facilities (5339 a+b) = \$1,002,457,603
- No/Low-Emission Bus (5339c) = \$180,000,000

#### • BIL — FY '22

- Total Transit Apportionment = \$20,378,500,393 (59%)
- Rural Transit (5311) = \$893,663,711 (23%)
- Tribal Transit (5311c1) = \$53,387,714 (49%)
- Urban Transit (5307) = \$6,920,874,612 (29%)
- Specialized (5310) = \$422,037,792 **(44%)**
- Bus and Bus Facilities (5339 a+b) = \$1,147,251,848
   (14%)
- No/Low-Emission Bus (5339c) = \$1,174,998,689
   (552%)
